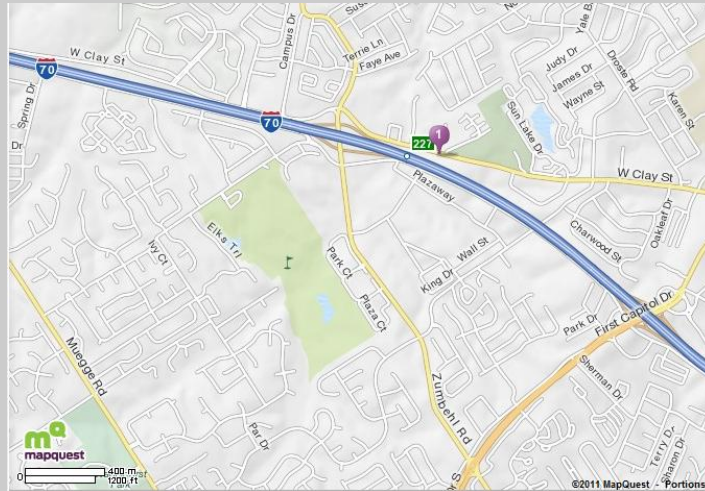
# Meeting Schedule
