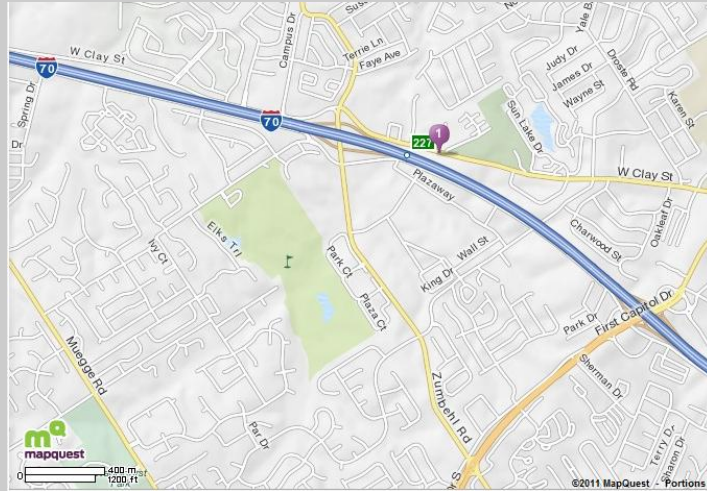
Meeting Schedule
