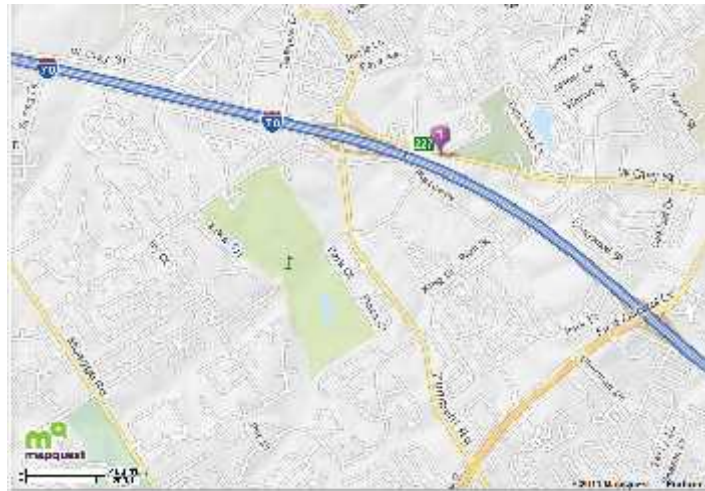
## Meeting Schedule

## Meeting Minutes

### September Meeting Minutes (10/9/2014)

Meeting called to order 10/09/2014 by President, Richard Jenkins.
